



SAIL THE ARGOLIC AND SARONIC GULF'S IN THE GREEK ISLANDS.



MAY 28TH – JUNE 4TH

In May 2016, on Memorial day weekend the Athens Sailing Academy is hosting a Flotilla that will sail in the Argolic and lower Saronic Gulfs. The Flotilla will visit the ports, of Erimoni, the port of Astros, the ancient city of Navplion, the birth place of King Leonidas, Leonidion and the island of Hydra.

Join us as we set off from the island of Poros, on May 28th. Sail the Hydra channel and then south to the Argolic gulf where the winds are a constant 15-20 knots. Enjoy the scenery and ancient history of the area. Sail in comfort on our Jeanneau class yachts, all of which are less than 2 years old. You can reserve a yacht as a whole party, or join a mixed party yacht. We have all sizes available from 32 ft. to 43 ft.

TERMS AND CONDITONS.

Not included are the docking or mooring fees, refuelling of the yacht on the last day, provisioning, dinners in restaurants, optional guided tours, as well as taxi to and from the airport, ferry tickets to the island. Pricing based on current Euro exchange rates and subject to adjustment in case of large fluctuations.

We board the yachts on Saturday afternoon and will be back at the base the following Friday evening. Payment terms: Payment of 50% should be made within eight days of the reservation date with the final balance due 45 days prior to departure. Price listed are gross prices and include Greek VAT.

Cancellations: Cancellations must be made in writing, by the signatory who booked the charter. If the cancellation is made more than 35 days before the departure date, the Company reserves the right to keep 50% of the total amount, and if the cancellation is made within 35 days before the departure date, the Company reserves the right to make no refund of the total amount. We suggest that, if you wish to obtain travel cancellation insurance, you contact Travel Guard (www.travelguard.com).

Captains: Greek law states that the skipper of a charter boat must have an internationally recognized barefoot charter certification or recognized captain's license. The ASA 104 (Bareboat Charter Certification) ASA will fulfil this requirement. If you or anyone in your crew does not possess an internationally recognized license, you will have to hire a captain. The cost of a captain per week is €1050.00, plus gratuity and food. The captain does not count as a paying member of the crew for the purpose of cost calculation.

Crew Matching: Unless you book with enough friends to crew a yacht by yourselves, we will match you up with other participants and fill up a yacht. We will do everything possible to match non-104 certified crewmembers with experienced and certified participants. This way, you avoid the cost of hiring a captain and you get to learn from more advanced sailors.
