Highlights of your sailing itinerary include:

Hol Chan & Shark Ray Alley

Local fishermen used to clean their catch at this famous spot, which attracted more carnivorous species such as big southern stingrays and nurse sharks. Also look out for yellowtail snapper, parrotfish, sergeant majors and French angelfish in amongst the coral.

Sail on to Hol Chan Marine Reserve, where you snorkel amongst beautiful shoals of tropical fish, turtles, eagle rays, stingrays, moray eels and grouper around the corals



Caye Caulker

'No shirt, no shoes, no problem' is the island motto and typifies the vibe. The white sandy beaches, ocean breezes, fresh seafood, azure waters and a fantastic barrier reef on its doorstep make it a perfect place to relax and unwind. 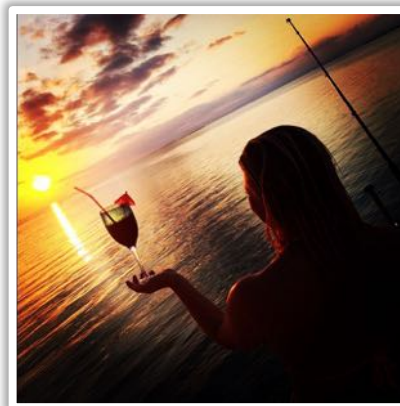
“La Isla Bonita” San Pedro

San Pedro, Ambergris Caye, is the northernmost Caye along the Belize barrier reef. Explore the buzzing little fishing town by foot, or for added fun rent a golf cart. Check out the local arts and craft stalls and enjoy a cocktail at a waterfront bar before returning to the boat for the catch of the day



St George's Caye

Steeped in history, it was the first capital of the British settlement. The island is principally home to private families, however it's a great base for scuba diving, snorkelling, island exploration or beach combing. Enjoy a top notch margarita at the St George's Caye Lodge before returning to the boat for dinner on deck.



Goff's Caye
